Transfer Opportunity Programs

If you are thinking about starting at a community college to transfer to a fouryear college, be sure to check out Transfer Admission Guarantee programs (also known as TAG).

It is really important to start researching NOW!

- 1. Transfer requirements you will need to take at the community college
- 1. What college you plan to transfer to (UC, CSU, private)
- What major you are transferring into (transfer students have to complete both general education and pre-major requirements)




