This <u>event</u> provides a broad overview of the academic program at Carlmont. The evening begins with campus tours in the Quad followed by a presentation in the Performing Arts Center from Carlmont Principal Ralph Crame with an overview of electives and our athletic program. Parents are then dismissed to classrooms to hear presentations from teachers in the four core subjects: English, Math, Science and Social Studies.

- **7:00 9:00 pm: Presentation** begins in the *Performing Arts Center* followed by visits to classrooms.
