<p>Oct 2, 2017 - Feb 2, 2018 4:00 p.m.</p>	<p><b>Open Enrollment Transfer Application</b> – Ninth Grade Open Enrollment is a period of time when an incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade student may request a high school other than their assigned home school to attend. The online "Open Enrollment Transfer Application" must be submitted by the deadline to be eligible and the <b>deadline to the Sequoia Union High School District is at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 2, 2018.</b> Please visit <a href="#"><u>Sequoia Union School District Open Enrollment</u></a> for complete instructions.</p>
<p>Nov 1, 2017 - Apr 27, 2018</p>	<p><b>Address Verification</b> – An address verification form must be on file for every student in the Sequoia Union High School District. <p>Spring 2018</p>	<p><b>Student Registration</b> – Registration for the incoming freshman class begins in spring 2018.
