

## TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION - ENGLISH

Take a look at the student's English coursework.

- Did the student pass 3 semesters of English?
- Did they earn C's or higher?
- Is there a "P" or "HP" after each English class?
- Is the student on track to graduate in English?

Is the student A-G eligible?

## TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION - MATH

- Did the student pass Algebra I or higher?
- Did the student pass a math class this school year?
- Is the student on track for Math graduation requirements?
- How many more math classes does the student need to pass to meet A-G requirements?

## TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION - PE

- Did the student pass four quarters of PE their freshman year?
- How many more credits of PE do they need to meet graduation requirements?

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





#### Transcript Evaluation and Course Selection

We will begin evaluating transcripts by looking at sample transcripts. Follow these general steps when evaluating transcripts:

- Identify any D's or F's. Depending on your post-secondary goals, these are courses you may need to recover.
- Evaluate the academic standing (graduation status, A-G status, GPA, etc.) by using the guidelines on the Transcript Evaluation Chart.
- 3. Identify next steps for credit recovery (if needed) and courses for next year

# COURSE SELECTION PROCESS




#### STEP 1



#### REGISTRATION APPTS

#### Scheduled for March:

- You will receive an **email** sent to your gmail account with your appt day and time.
