A-G requirements

The A-G requirements are the courses required to meet admissions standards for the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems.

The intent of the “a-g” subject requirements is to ensure that students have attained a body of general knowledge that will provide breadth and perspective to new, more advanced study.

A-G requirements

Meeting Eligibility Requirements:

Students must pass all A-G requirements with a C- or higher. *What if my student earns a D or F grade?*

- Repeat course
- Validation (math or world language)
- STUDENT SHOULD MEET WITH THEIR COUNSELOR

Finally, students are required to take the SAT or ACT.

CSU Selection: Index Ranking

SAT formula:

$\text{CSU GPA} \times 800 + [\text{SAT Critical Reading} + \text{Math}]$

ACT formula:

$\text{CSU GPA} \times 200 + [\text{ACT composite multiplied by } 10]$

2950 SAT or 694 ACT Index

Naviance is a tool to:

1. learn about yourself
2. explore careers
3. learn about colleges and majors
4. search for scholarships and financial aid
5. request letters of recommendations for colleges and scholarships

Self-Assessment

Naviance has a variety of self-assessment tools for students to learn more about **themselves**, their **learning style**, and potential **careers** that might fit their personality.

Career Information

- Naviance groups careers by category
- Data about each career including description, tasks, education, and wages (based on geographic location)
- As students find careers that interest them, they can save that information

What we do with students

- 10th grade – Strengths Explorer
- 11th grade – “Do What You Are”
- 12th grade – College applications, college research, letters of recommendation, scholarship search

Strengths Explorer

Strengths Explorer is a strengths assessment that assesses 10 talent themes for individuals and identifies each student's **three strongest emerging talents**. Upon completion of Strengths Explorer, students will be provided with explanations of their **top three themes** and will learn how to capitalize on their success and discover what they need to do next to continue building on their strengths.

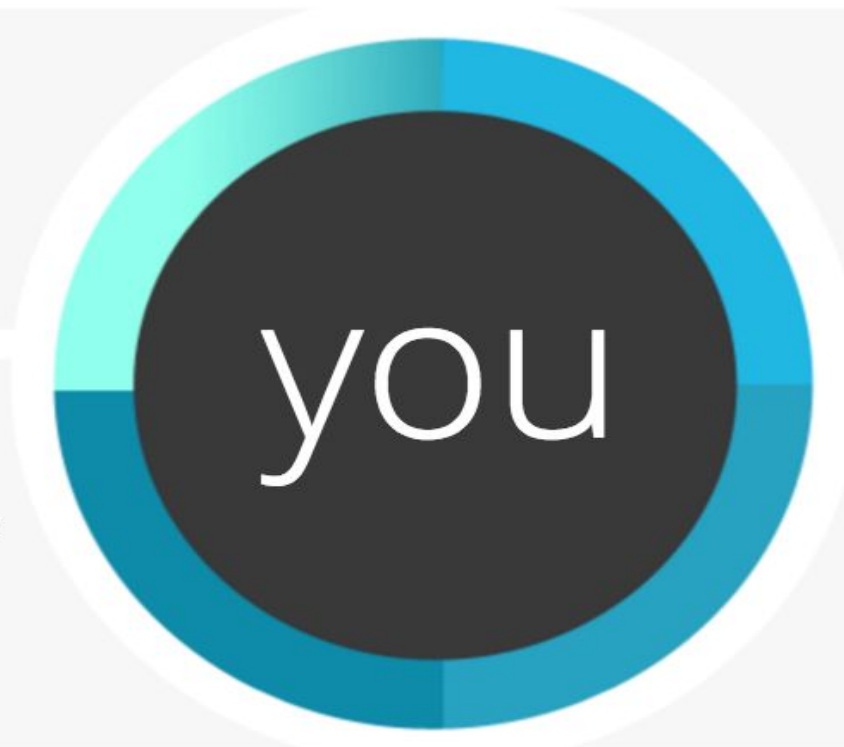

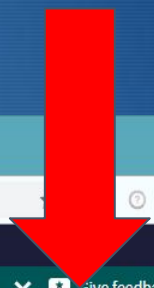

How can parents use Naviance to help your students

- Let your student take **ownership** of the college application process
- **Resume** - Encourage your student to log activities and awards beginning in ninth grade
- Encourage your student to complete **self assessments**
 - Talk about your students' results – what are their strengths, interests, and goals
 - Talk about career possibilities
- Search for colleges together to consider for their list of “Colleges I’m Thinking About”. Look at the schools’ admission data. Be realistic about your student’s **goals and limitations** and set a **reasonable range** of schools.
