Transcript Evaluation and Course Selection

We will begin evaluating transcripts by looking at sample transcripts. Follow these general steps when evaluating transcripts:

1. Identify any D's or F's. Depending on your post-secondary goals, these are courses you may need to recover.
2. Evaluate the academic standing (graduation status, A-G status, GPA, etc.) by using the guidelines on the Transcript Evaluation Chart.
3. Identify next steps for credit recovery (if needed) and courses for next year

4. Look for an email with your appointment time to see your counselor to finalize course selections

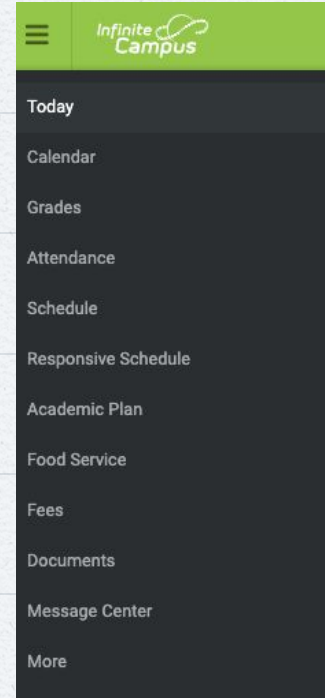

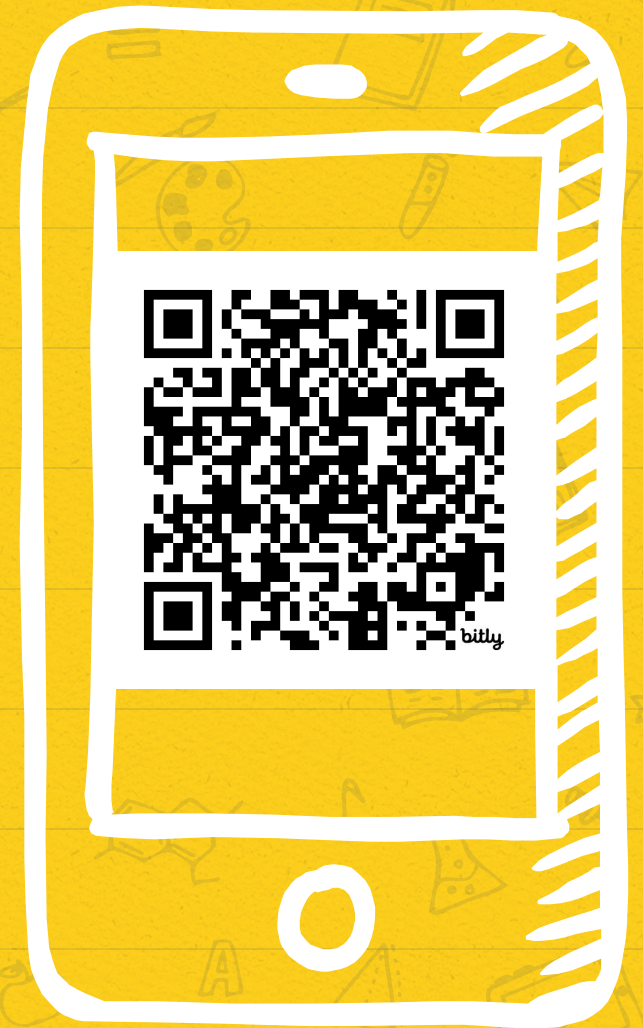

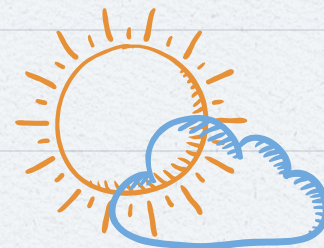
