Guidelines on 7th course request eligibility

Who qualifies for 7 classes:

- AVID
- ASB/ Leadership
- Sports Leadership
- Yearbook
- support classes (support and Study Skills)
- juniors & seniors who need 7 for graduation
- 9th-10th graders in PE + Performing Arts
- BTI 11th graders MAY take 7 IF they are taking World Language
(BTI 10th graders do not automatically qualify for 7 classes)

Who can request 7 classes:

- 10-12th graders in Performing Arts and w/o PE go on a waitlist → “7th period request”
- The qualifying class must be listed in the priority 1-6 class requests


Add Your Four-Year Plan to Infinite Campus
